
NOTICE TO STUDENTS AND STAFF- CONCESSIONS FOR STUDENTS LEFT WITH 2 AND LESS MODULES TO GRADUATE

The Executive Management Committee (EMC), at its ordinary meeting held on 17 February 2025, approved the following concessions to assist students with financial challenges:

- To allow students left with 2 and less modules to graduate, but are unable to register due to financial issues, to be allowed to register, provided they pay the registration fee and sign an acknowledgement of debt form (AOD).
- This concession excludes students with G20 exclusion.

To implement this resolution, the following needs to happen:

- These students will need to approach Finance, who will check them against a list with the names of students in this category.
- Students who don't appear on the list but believe they are left with 2 or less modules can print out their academic reports and approach their academic Departments so they can confirm by signing on the academic record that these students do qualify for the concession.
- Students are urged to finalise the payment of the registration fee and the signing of the AOD in time for them to register during the Registration Amnesty Period of 3-4 March 2025.
